Worship will continue with one service at 10:30 on Sundays in the sanctuary and online on Facebook and Zoom.

1. Capacity and seating are no longer limited. Signing up in advance is not required, but worshippers will be checked in at the beginning of services so we can continue to have a record of participants for communion records and contact tracing, if it becomes necessary.
2. Masks will be optional.-The small chapel downstairs, which has the closed-circuit video feed, is reserved for anyone who wants additional distance.
3. We will resume singing all of the hymns on Sunday, November 28.
4. There are no changes regarding tabulators.
5. The passing of the peace, offering collection and communion will continue to be observed in the same manner.
6. There are no restrictions on eating or drinking in the fellowship hall.
7. If you have a fever or any symptoms of illness, please stay at home and worship online.

If you think you may have been exposed to COVID-19, contact your healthcare provider immediately. Most people have mild illness and are able to recover at home. If you have been at church and you become sick, please notify Pastor Christina. She will work with local health officials to follow up on next steps. Individual names will not be released to the congregation.

These guidelines replace previous policies that have been in place during the pandemic.
